



- Within 3 days before arrival: 100% tour price.

13.30: Have lunch while cruising to magnificent Bai Tu Long Bay. We start sailing among famous Islets (Indochina studio, Am Islets...) of Bai Tu Long Bay.

15.15 - 15.40: Visit and explore the Thien Canh Son Cave and Kayaking.

18.00: Sunset party


