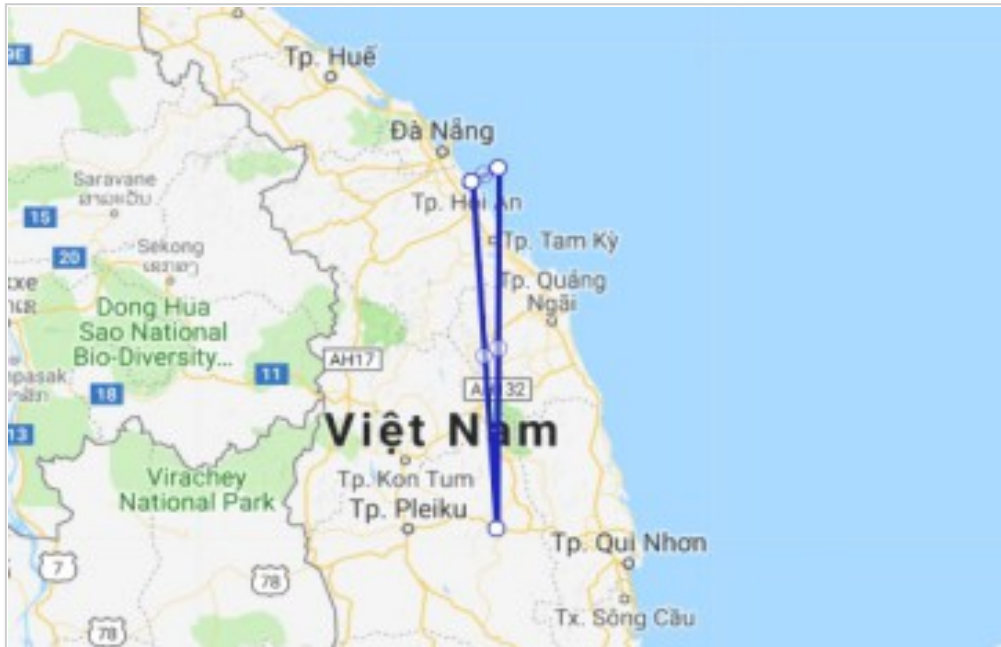
## Trip Overview
